

Using the Dress the Miner Activity Template

The Dress the Miner activity template allows you to facilitate a group activity in which trainees can become familiar with how to use PPE to control hazards in particular scenarios. Add your own scenarios to customize training for your needs.

Following the title slide, the template consists of an instruction slide, a blank scenario slide, four *dress the miner* slides, and then several slides illustrating an example scenario in which noise exposure must be controlled. Run the slideshow starting from slide 8 to see how it works.

Blank scenario slide: Edit this slide to create a scenario around controlling hazards with PPE. Duplicate this slide for as many different scenarios you need for your activity.

Dress the miner slides: Duplicate the appropriate slide(s) to include with each scenario. Use animations to move the correct PPE onto the miner upon clicking. For more sophisticated interaction, use animation triggers. See slides 18 and 19 in the example to see how.

Example scenario slides: This example is included to demonstrate how the Dress the Miner activity can be an integral part of a larger lesson about controlling hazards. Adapt these slides and their animations as you see fit for your own Dress the Miner activity.
